Why is the Wolves Wellness Center changing?

As West Clermont Local Schools continue to grow, there is an increased need for instructional space. The space currently used for the Wolves Wellness Center will transition back to instructional space.

Is HealthSource leaving West Clermont?

HealthSource's partnership with West Clermont is continuing. While services will no longer be located inside the school building, HealthSource remains committed to caring for West Clermont students, families, and the community.

When will this change take effect?

Friday, May 15th will be the last day that HealthSource will see patients in the space. Beginning Monday, May 18th, HealthSource will see patients at the identified locations.

Where will medical services be provided?

Medical services will continue with the same trusted provider and care team:

Will my child still be able to receive care from HealthSource?

Will this impact appointments already scheduled?

HealthSource is working closely with West Clermont leadership to ensure a smooth transition. Families will be contacted directly if any appointments are impacted. These changes will not go into effect until May 18, 2026.

Will services return to West Clermont schools in the future?
